The Dreaming

Waa!'s production of the Dreaming based on Howard Goodall's musical version of A Midsummers Nights Dream was a great musical spectacle, and also very good theatre. We can only marvel at the dedication of all the local young people involved in this production from the technical team and the actors to the wonderful bunch of volunteers who supported the youth to deliver a fabulous evening's entertainment right in the heart of Fishguard. It is reminiscent of one of those blockbuster musicals of the late 1980s, where you found yourself marvelling at everything that had been thrown up during the show, each intricate scene involving at least 10 young people against a forest backdrop of aluminium trees and woven together by well choreographed movement and song. It could only be described as the best youth Theatre event presented at the Theatr Gwaun.
